☞ LIGHT BODIED — LIVELY, BRIGHT

- Pinot Noir | 2022 Valmoissine by Louis Latour — Haut Var, France** 58
Fresh style with **red cherry, wild strawberry**, subtle spice, **soft tannins**, bright acidity. 91 pts Decanter.
- Pinot Noir | 2023 Bishop's Peak — San Luis Obispo, California** 52
Bishop's Peak is the companion label produced by Talley Vineyards, one of the most admired family-run estates in California's San Luis Obispo Coast AVA. **Raspberry, cranberry, pomegranate**, coastal salinity, silky tannins. 90 pts WE.
- Grenache | 2023 Villa Creek 'SOul' Maha Estate Vineyard — Paso Robles, CA** 59
Founded in 2001 Villa Creek has become one of the most respected small producers in Paso Robles. Known for biodynamic/regenerative farming. Vibrant **red fruit, blood orange, white pepper**, dusty earth, **fine tannins**. 93 pts Wine Advocate.
- Gamay | 2022 Nicole Chanrion Côte de Brouilly — Beaujolais, FR** 65
A Historic, Woman-Led Domaine in the Heart of Beaujolais is one of the most revered small estates in Beaujolais. **Crushed violets, cherry, granite minerality, lively acidity**. 94 pts Vinous.
- Barbera | 2023 Elena Giuseppe Barbera d'Alba — Piedmont** 49
A Family Estate Rooted in Generations of Barbera Tradition. **Black cherry, plum, lavender, bright acidity**. 91 pts James Suckling.

☞ LIGHT BODIED — SUPPLE, FRUIT-FORWARD

- Red Blend | GOAT Juice — California** 45
Aromatic and fruit driven style. **Ripe cherry, blackberry compote, mocha**; plush and smooth.
- Pinot Noir | Villa Wolf —Pfalz, Germany** 54
Light-to-medium bodied, bright and food-friendly. **Juicy red cherry and cranberry** with subtle spice, a touch of **earth**, and soft, approachable tannins. Clean & balanced.

☞ MEDIUM BODIED — RED FRUITS, MODERATE TANNINS

- Sangiovese | Querceto Chianti Classico — Tuscany, Italy** 53
Founded in 1897, Castello di Querceto, located hills of Greve in Chianti, is one of the most historic properties, lodged in an 11th C. castle. **Red cherry, herbs, leather, floral spice, lively acidity**. 92 pts Wine Spectator.

- Montepulciano | 2020 Coste di Moro — Abruzzo, Italy** 41
 Coste di Moro is produced by Cantina Orsogna, a forward-thinking, biodynamic cooperative founded in 1964. **Blackberry, plum, dark chocolate, crushed stone.** 91 pts James Suckling.
- Nero d’Avola · Frappato | 2023 La Planeta Cerasuolo di Vittoria DOCG — Sicily** 73
Planeta is one of Sicily’s most influential wine families, known for combining rigorous scientific research and respect for Sicilian heritage. **Red berries, blood orange, rose petal, soft spice.** 93 pts Wine Advocate.
- Pinot Noir | 2022 Funky Jory — Dundee Hills, Oregon** 74
 This is a boutique Pinot Noir project, showcasing the signature character of **Jory soil**—the deep, iron-rich, volcanic earth that defines the Dundee Hills AVA. **Red fruit, rose petal, warm spice, silky tannins.** 94 pts Vinous.
- Pinot Noir | 2021 Sea Floored — Sta. Rita Hills, CA** 74
 Sea Floored is a boutique Pinot Noir label crafted to highlight the dramatic maritime terroir of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA. **Black cherry, hibiscus, saline minerality.** 94 pts Jeb Dunnuck.
- Pinot Noir | 2022 Michel Sarrazin Maranges Burgundy, France** 115
 This is a highly regarded family-run estate located in the Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy’s southernmost red-wine appellation. Maranges is known as one of Burgundy’s most exciting sources for elegant & structured Pinot Noir. **Strawberry, cherry, limestone, fine tannins.** 93 pts WA.
- Merlot | 2022 LUKE — Wahluke Slope, Washington** 44
 Founded by Luke and Amy Bradford to show **Wahluke Slope**, one of Washington’s warmest and most distinctive AVAs. **Dark plum, cocoa, cedar, graphite.** 91 pts WS
- Sangiovese | 2019 Poggerino Chianti Classico (Magnum) — Italy** 159
Poggerino is a highly respected, family-run estate located in **Radda in Chianti**, one of the highest and coolest areas in Chianti Classico. **Cherry, tobacco, herbs, refined tannins.** 95 pts Wine Enthusiast
- Tannat | 2022 Garzón Reserva — Uruguay** 45
Bodega Garzón is one of South America’s most celebrated modern wineries, credited with elevating Uruguay onto the global fine-wine stage **Black fruit, violet, graphite, firm tannins.** 92 pts Decanter
- Grenache | 2021 Torbreck Hillside Vineyard — Barossa, Australia** 54
 Torbreck become one of the Barossa Valley’s most revered estates, celebrated for producing powerful, yet finely crafted wines with **some of the oldest productive vines on Earth- 150 years old.** **Raspberry, cherry liqueur, spice.** 93 pts Wine Spectator

Syrah · Grenache | 2022 Stéphane Ogier 'Le Temps Est Venu' Côtes du Rhône, FR 53
Stéphane Ogier is widely considered one of the greatest winemakers of his generation in the Rhône Valley, known for elegance. **Blackberry, violets, pepper, herbs.** 92pts Dunnuck

Red Blend | 2023 Merkin Chupacabra Buhl Vineyard Cochise, Arizona 70
A bold **Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre** blend from Maynard James Keenan, front man of Tool, A Perfect Circle, & Puscifer. **Ripe red cherries**, hints of **plum**, and **black pepper** mingle in this medium bodied wine. Clean & approachable.

LUSH, HEDONISTIC FRUIT

Corvina | 2023 Tenuta Sant'Antonio Amarone — Veneto, Italy 88
One of the leading modern producers in Valpolicella, founded by the Castagnedi brothers. **Dried cherry, fig, espresso, spice box, velvety tannins.** 94 pts James Suckling.

GSM Blend | 2022 Juliette Avril Châteauneuf-du-Pape — Rhône, France 78
Historic, family-run domaine whose origins trace back to the **18th century**. The Avril family were among the early winegrowers shaping the region. Their name is woven into the appellation's history. **Black raspberry, kirsch, garrigue, crushed stone.** 93 pts WA

Zinfandel | 2022 'Fidelity' Railyard Vineyard — Alexander Valley 53
Fidelity is a focused label under the direction of Nick Goldschmidt, one of Sonoma County's most respected consulting winemakers with more than 30 years of high-end winemaking experience. **Plum, boysenberry, baking spice; plush.** 90 pts Wine Enthusiast.

MEDIUM-PLUS TANNINS, ELEGANT BALANCE

Malbec | 2023 Loscano 'Grand Reserve' — Mendoza, Argentina 53
A gorgeous aromatic and fruit driven wine. **Blackberry, cocoa, herbs,** plush palate. 92 pts James Suckling.

Shiraz | 2020 Ladies Who Shoot Their Lunch — Victoria, Australia 78
A premium label created by one of the most innovative producers in the Strathbogie Ranges of Central Victoria. **Blackberry compote, violets, pepper, rich tannins.** 94 pts Halliday.

Red Blend | 2021 Nyers 'Sage Canyon' — Napa Valley 70
Nyers is a boutique Napa Valley winery founded on a simple principle: produce small-lot, vineyard-expressive wines that highlight Napa's historic Rhône and field-blend traditions. **Cherry, herbs, spice; supple tannins.** 93 pts Vinous.

- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2023 Architect — Alexander Valley** 56
 A precision-driven cabernet project focused on structure & site spearheaded by Michael Broadbent, Master of Wine. **Cassis, graphite, bay leaf, firm tannins, polished.** 91 pts Wine Enthusiast
- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2019 Kiona Estate — Red Mountain** 59
 Kiona Vineyards is one of the founding estates of the Red Mountain AVA, planting their first vines in 1975, long before the secret was out about the quality in this region. **Cherry, eucalyptus, cedar, structure.** 94 pts Wine Enthusiast.
- Zinfandel | 2016 Wild Hog Vineyard — Fort Ross-Seaview** 74
 Wild Hog Vineyard is a tiny, fiercely independent, **off-the-grid** estate located in the rugged coastal mountains in Fort Ross–Seaview AVA. **Blackberry, Wild berry,pepper, dried herb.** 93 pts Wine Advocate.
- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2022 Scattered Peaks — Napa Valley** 69
 A boutique Napa Cabernet label from Joel Aiken, whose 30 years at Beaulieu Vineyard inform Scattered Peaks' focus on purity and site expression. **Cassis, cocoa nib, espresso.** 90 pts James Suckling.
- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2022 Truchard Vineyards — Carneros** 72
 One of the pioneering estates in Carneros, the **Truchard Vineyards** put quality grape growing on the map in this cool-climate region. **Wild blackberries, violets, and tobacco leaf.** 91 pts James Suckling.
- Red Blend | Eshcol by Trefethen — Napa Valley** 61
 Trefethen Family Vineyards has been a respected presence in Napa Valley since 1968. **Black fruit, herbs, mocha.** 92 pts Wine Spectator.
- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2018 Heitz Cellar — Napa Valley** 199
 Heitz Cellar was founded in 1961 **by** Joe Heitz, a visionary winemaker whose early focus on quality and site expression helped define modern Napa Cabernet Sauvignon **Mint, blackberry, graphite, cigar box.** 96 pts Wine Advocate.
- POWERFUL, INTENSE**
- Red Blend | 2022 Leviathan — Oakville** 68
 A modern California red blend crafted under the guidance of renowned winemaker Andy Erickson, a veteran winemaker long associated with producing Super-Premium, cult wines. **Blueberry, blackberry, graphite, dark chocolate.** 92 pts Wine Enthusiast.
- Sangiovese | 2020 Castello di Ama Riserva 'Montebuoni' — Tuscany** 94
 One of the most esteemed estates in Chianti Classico DOCG, in Gaiol. The estate traces its vinous roots to the 11th century. **Pure lush elegance. Sour cherry, plum, rose, tea leaf, spice.** 95 pts James Suckling.

- Cabernet Sauvignon | 2022 Caymus 50th Anniversary — Napa** 174
This iconic estate champions rich, fruit forward styles. **Blackberry syrup, vanilla, baking spice, plush** mouthfeel. 92 pts Wine Spectator.
- Sangiovese | 2019 Cerbaia Brunello di Montalcino — Tuscany** 130
Cerbaia is a family-owned, woman led company that produces wines from some of Montalcino's finest vineyards. **Cherry, leather, herbs, firm tannins**. 98pts JamesSuckling
- Cabernet Sauv · Merlot | 2019 Chateau Marquis de Terme — Margaux** 95
A Cabernet-forward Margaux with classic Left Bank elegance: **perfumed violet** and **blackcurrant** on the nose, layered with **cocoa, graphite**, and a touch of **cedar**. The 2nd label of a 4th growth Cru Classé. 93 pts James Suckling
- Cabernet Sauvignon Blend | 2018 Les Tourelles de Longueville — Pauillac** 129
Les Tourelles de Longueville is the acclaimed second wine of Château Pichon-Longueville Comtesse de Lalande, one of Bordeaux's most storied Left Bank. **Blackcurrant, cigar box, graphite**. 93 pts James Suckling.
- Nebbiolo | 2018 San Silvestro Barolo Riserva — Piedmont** 89
A Novello-based family estate, San Silvestro has been producing traditional Piedmont wines under the Sartirano family since 1871. Classic Riserva profile: **rose petal, sweet tobacco, red cherry, savory herbs, firm Barolo structure**. 94 pts James Suckling.
